



## **Appointment as the Director Centre for Biomedical Ethics**

The Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine at the National University of Singapore is seeking candidates for appointment at full professorial level to the Directorship of the Centre for Biomedical Ethics (CBmE), in succession to the inaugural director, Professor. Alastair V. Campbell who has helmed this position since 2006.

Under Professor Campbell's leadership, CBmE has become a centre of excellence for the region as a whole, offering training courses and conferences with international speakers and participants. The Centre is a member of the Global Alliance for Biomedical Ethics Centers (GABEX), and also has research links with HUGO, WHO, The Hastings Centre and several universities in Australasia, Europe and the USA. The Centre also publishes a peer reviewed quarterly journal, the *Asian Bioethics Review*.

CBmE runs the Health Ethics, Law and Professionalism (HELP) track, through all five years of the undergraduate medical curriculum. In addition, it offers postgraduate study in biomedical ethics at both Master's and Doctoral level, and has a vibrant Visiting Fellows programme. There are 8 full time and 7 part time academic and research staff in the Centre supported by 4 administrative staff. Applicants should have a strong record of scholarship in medical ethics and bioethics and experience of leadership, teaching and research in biomedical ethics education, ideally within a medical school. An attractive remuneration package will be offered with this prestigious position, commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience. Leave and medical benefits will be provided, as well as housing benefits and relocation expenses (if applicable). It is hoped that the successful candidate will be available to take up the position no later than July 2012.
