Postdoctoral fellow

(E 13 TV-L, 100%, or 2 x 50%)

The post is established as part of the research group „**Personalized medicine in oncology: an interdisciplinary analysis on ethical, medical, economical and legal aspects**“ funded by the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research. The post is presently limited to two years; an extension is possible.

The profile of the research posts comprises 1.) research in the subproject “ethics” (heads: Dr. Jan Schildmann, Prof. Jochen Vollmann) and 2.) the scientific coordination of the whole interdisciplinary research group (speaker: Prof. Jochen Vollmann). The full-time post (E TV-L 13, 100%) can with respect to the two different fields be divided into part-time positions. There is the possibility to receive further academic qualifications on post-doc level or a doctorate degree. Applicants should have a degree in medicine, philosophy, social sciences, psychology or comparable fields. Previous work in the field of medical ethics is of advantage. Intellectual ability, interest in interdisciplinary research, flexibility, and the ability to work as member of a team as well as proficiency in the English language are prerequisites. The institute works interdisciplinary. Ethical aspects of medical research and clinical ethics form part of our main research focus on which we work in international research collaborations. The working languages in our institute are German and English.

In accordance with the Ruhr-Universität’s internationalisation strategy, we also expressly invite applications from abroad. The Ruhr-Universität Bochum is committed to promoting the careers of women in areas in which they are under-represented and, therefore, actively welcomes applications from female candidates.
