I would like to remind speakers who have not yet registered, to do so asap (a registration form is attached to this letter). Those who have not registered by June 15th will have their names removed from the final programme.

With this, we hope to avoid gaps in the actual conference sessions.

ESPMH General Assembly

On behalf of the ESPMH Board, I would also like to invite you to attend the General Assembly of our Society, which will take place on Friday 25 August 2023 (17.00-18.00 hrs). Please find a (draft-) agenda in the attachment.

ESPMH Election

In an earlier letter (from 12 January 2023) we invited you to nominate candidates for two positions in the Board of the ESPMH. The three-year term of office of secretary of the ESPMH (Bert Gordijn) as well as the three-year term of office of one board member (Fuat Oduncu) will both end on December 31 of this year, which means that these two positions will also be open for election in Riga.

In reaction to the invitation to propose candidates for these two positions, we have received no nomination for the position of secretary. Bert Gordijn has however indicated that he is willing to serve another term as secretary of the society. For the position of regular board member, we have received two nominations: Johanna Ahola-Launonen and Cristina Richie. Moreover, Fuat Oduncu has indicated that he is willing to serve another term as regular board member.

Thus, the Board's election proposal is as follows:

Secretary of the ESPMH: Bert Gordijn

According to the by-laws concerning the election procedure, a candidate can be elected without ballots if there is only one candidate for a position and the General Assembly unanimously agrees.

For the position of Regular Board member there will be one ballot with the names of all three candidates.

ESPMH members attending the General Assembly in Riga can vote in person. Members who are unable to attend the meeting but still care to vote, should email the ESPMH Secretariat to request postal ballots. These ballots should be resent to the Secretariat **by June 15** or alternatively handed in (via an attending colleague) to the Secretary at the Riga conference before the start of the General Assembly.
