

ESPMH PhD Student Awards 2024

The *European Society for Philosophy of Medicine and Healthcare* (ESPMH) invites submissions for two awards for PhD students in 2024. The awards will be granted to PhD students for a scientific contribution on ethical, epistemological, or other philosophical issues relating to medicine and health care. Eligible papers must be single authored and unpublished.

The papers must be original work with a maximum word count of 6,000 excluding bibliography and footnotes. Contributions must be written in English and submitted **before March 1st, 2024.** The jury will consist of members of the board of the ESPMH, who may decide to invite additional external reviewers. Language problems will be considered in the rating of contributions by non-native speakers.

The first prize consists of an award of \in 2,000 and the second prize of \in 1,500. The award can help to cover travel and accommodation expenditures for an invited participation in the next ESPMH Conference to be held in Frankfurt/ Offenbach, Germany, 21-24 August 2024. The award-winning works will be presented by the young scholars at the conference.
