**ESPMH Young Scholar Awards 2023** 

The European Society for Philosophy of Medicine and Health Care (ESPMH) invites submissions for 2

ESPMH awards for Young Scholars for the year 2023. The awards will be granted to scholars younger

than 35 years of age for a scientific contribution on ethical, epistemological, or other philosophical

issues relating to medicine and health care. Eligible papers must be single authored and unpublished.

The papers must be original work with a maximum word count of 6,000 excluding bibliography and

footnotes. Contributions must be written in English and must be submitted before March 1st, 2023.

The jury will consist of members of the Board of the ESPMH, who may decide to invite additional

external reviewers. Language problems will be considered in the rating of contributions by non-native

speakers.

The first prize consists of an award of € 2,000 and the second prize of an award of € 1,500 to cover

travel and accommodation expenditures for an invited participation in the  $\underline{\mathsf{next}}$   $\underline{\mathsf{ESPMH}}$   $\underline{\mathsf{Conference}}$  to

be held in Riga, Latvia, 23 – 26 August 2023.

The award-winning works will be presented by the young scholars at the Conference.
