The research centre “Ethics of Genome Editing” at the Institute of Ethics and History of Medicine, University of Tübingen, is inviting applications for the position of

Postdoctoral Researcher (m/f/d; TV-L E13, 100%)

with a focus on the ethics of genome editing. The research centre “Ethics of Genome Editing” documents the development of genome editing technologies and explores their normative aspects. This is a full-time position. The regular working week is currently set at 39.5 hours. The position should start at the earliest possible date and will be limited to 20 months, with the possibility of an extension of additional three years (subject to a final funding decision). The post-holder is encouraged to pursue the degree of Habilitation.

Responsibilities

- Research on ethical aspects of genome editing and development of innovative ideas in this field.
- Work with the research group on preparing publications and organizing academic events.
- Assist in the preparation of grant applications and management of research projects, as well as in the dissemination of research results.

Requirements

- A university degree in philosophy (with a focus on ethics or practical philosophy), social science, science and technology studies (STS), law, medicine or related disciplines with a focus on ethics/applied ethics/medical ethics or technology assessment/governance.
- Strong command of the English language.
- Knowledge about ethical or technical aspects of genome editing is desirable.
- Experience of applying for research grants and managing research projects is desirable.

We offer a salary according to the tariff agreement for state employees (TV-L), salary level E13, as well as all benefits common in state employment. Disabled persons will be preferred in case of equal qualification. The University seeks to raise the number of women in research and teaching and therefore urges qualified women to apply. The contract will be made by the Central Administration of the University.
